What can be funded:

- Children and Young People
- Education
- Health and Medical
- Community Activities
- Older People's Projects
- Wildlife Conservation

What cannot be funded:

- Sponsorships
- Animal Charities
- Individuals or projects that generate income for personal gain
- Retrospective grants
- Replacing statutory responsibility (for example school curriculum activities)
- Political campaigns
- Promotion of religious groups or religious campaigns
- Anything that could bring the reputation of the Charity into disrepute
- Repayment of loans or debts.

Who can apply:

Constituted voluntary and community groups based and operating but not exclusively, in South East Northumberland.

The deadline dates for submitting completed applications (with all necessary supporting documents) are the 25th of January (for the March meeting) and the 25th July (for the September meeting).
